Also more commonly known as the System of Record




Benefits

- ✓ Single Version of the Truth
- ✓ Usable Information
- ✓ Longitudinal information regarding education




Each person is assigned a randomly generated identifier that is lifelong across time, location and source system.

How do we keep the System of Record clean?



Authoritative Source



- ✓ States can set a source system reliability scores
- ✓ Only authoritative sources will update master data
- ✓ Enables record-level updates to information based upon a system-wide source system reliability score
- ✓ The reliability score is used during the Match Processing to determine if the incoming record is permitted to update an existing record






How are States Leveraging the Uniq-ID Data?













Build Reliability at the Field Level

States will be able to set reliability levels at a more granular level and merge records across systems



Combine data from multiple information systems and agencies
